

2024 Competition and Rules Leadership Committee Official Election Results

A total of 501 NSDA chapters cast a ballot for the Competition and Rules Leadership Committee (California = 103, East/Northeast = 117, Northern Midwest = 162, and Northwest/Northwest Central = 119). The individual receiving the highest preferential score within each of the four regions receives a seat on the committee beginning August 1, 2024. Each member will serve a three-year term ending July 31, 2027. The remaining candidates will serve as alternates. If an elected position should become vacant prior to the next election, alternates, in order of finish, will be invited to the seat.
